



(b) I am the elected Vice President of Local 72 and the elected Trustee of Local 858.

(c) I am the elected President of Teamsters Joint Council No. 16 and the elected Vice President of the IBT.

(d) I am a Trustee and the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Teamsters Joint Council No. 16 Pension Fund.

(e) I am an elected member of the Policy Committee of the Eastern Conference of Teamsters and have been elected as the Chairman of the Eastern Conference Policy Committee.

(f) I am a Trustee and Chairman of the Eastern Conference of Teamsters Retirement Plan.

4. I shall resign from all of the offices, positions and memberships listed in paragraph 3 above on October 25, 1991. Furthermore, I will not seek or accept election or appointment to any office or position, paid or unpaid, with the International Union or any of its affiliated organizations, nor will I seek or accept any employment, consulting or other similar relationship of any kind with the International Union or any of its affiliated organizations.

5. Although I was an accredited and nominated candidate for Eastern Regional Vice President of the International Union, I have withdrawn as a candidate for Eastern Regional Vice President.

6. I agree that this Agreement will be submitted to the Independent Administrator for his review and approval. Prior to his execution of this Agreement, I will provide the Independent Administrator with copies of my letters of resignation from all of the offices, positions and memberships listed in paragraph 3 above. If approved by the Independent Administrator, I understand that he will submit this Agreement to the District Court for that Court to enter it as an Order.


7. The Investigations Officer makes no representation as to any action that may be taken by the Independent Administrator or the Court with respect to this Agreement. In the event that either the Court or the Independent Administrator do not approve this Agreement, I may elect to proceed with the hearing on the charges.

8. I make this Agreement freely, under no duress of any kind, after consultation with my attorney.

9. This Agreement is not effective until the Order is entered by Judge David N. Edelstein.

You are hereby advised that the Investigations Officer has charged you with the violations listed below in accordance with the powers granted to him pursuant to Section F. (COURT APPOINTED OFFICERS), Paragraph 12(A) of the order entered in United States v. International Brotherhood of Teamsters, et al., 88 Civ. 4486 (DNE) (SDNY) on March 14, 1989. A copy of that order is attached.

The time and place for the hearing of this matter will be determined by the Independent Administrator, Frederick B. Lacey, and he will notify you accordingly.

Charge


You are charged with acting in a manner to bring reproach upon the IBT, violating your fiduciary duties as an IBT

officer, violating your oath, in violation of Article II, § 2(a) and Article XIX, § 6(b) (1), and (2) of the IBT Constitution.

TO WIT, you deliberately failed to investigate and act with regard to matters concerning fellow officers of Joint Council 16 when you had a duty to investigate and act. These matters include allegations of knowing involvement with organized crime by Pasquale Crapanzano, Bernard Adelstein, and Anthony Distinti; and in United States v. IBT, 88 Civ. 4486 (DNE), the refusal of Pasquale Crapanzano, then Vice President, Anthony Distinti, then Recording Secretary, Bernard Adelstein, then Secretary-Treasurer, and Gerald Corallo, then Trustee of Joint Council 16, to testify because truthful testimony would have tended to incriminate them.
