

Procedures for December 3, 2021 Hearing

The hearing to determine the sanctions in the matter concerning Rome Aloise will be held on December 3, 2021 at 1 p.m. in a conference room at Bracewell LLP's offices located on the 49th floor at 1251 Avenue of the Americas, New York, New York 10020.

The hearing shall be open to members in good standing subject to space limitations in the conference room, which can accommodate approximately 15 members. Visitors to Bracewell must have their names entered into the building's security system prior to entering the building. Accordingly, members in good standing must contact the IRO and register to attend the proceeding. Attendance will be limited to the first 15 members who register.

In order to register for attendance at the hearing, members must contact Hayley Allis by email at hayley.allis@bracewell.com, indicate that they plan to attend the hearing on December 3, 2021, and provide their name and local union affiliation. Designated union personnel shall ensure that anyone who plans to attend the hearing is a current member in good standing. Additionally, prior to entering the conference room, members shall turn in their cell phones to Bracewell staff, which will be returned once the hearing is completed. No one who attends the hearing shall be permitted to record, video or photograph the proceeding. In addition, the hearing will not be broadcasted to members via Zoom or other video conferencing technology, which was done previously in this matter as an accommodation due to the pandemic.

Visitors should be vaccinated before attending the proceeding, however, please note that Bracewell's building requires that unvaccinated visitors remain masked when in the building.
